



## Echinokokóza - eu "case" definice

ECHINOCOCCOSIS

(*Echinococcus* spp)

### Clinical Criteria

Not relevant for surveillance purposes

### Diagnostic Criteria

At least one of the following five:

- Histopathology or parasitology compatible with *Echinococcus multilocularis* or *granulosus* (e.g. direct visualization of the protoscolex in cyst fluid)
- Detection of *Echinococcus granulosus* pathognomonic macroscopic morphology of cyst(s) in surgical specimens
- Typical organ lesions detected by imaging techniques (e.g.: computerized tomography, sonography, MRI) AND confirmed by a serological test
- *Echinococcus* spp. specific serum antibodies by high-sensitivity serological test AND confirmed by a high specificity serological test
- Detection of *Echinococcus multilocularis* or *granulosus* nucleic acid in a clinical specimen

**Epidemiological Criteria** NA

### Case Classification

Any person meeting the diagnostic criteria
