The list of the CEM National Reference Laboratories (NRLs)

The Centre of Epidemiology and Microbiology (CEM) Laboratories of the National Institute of Public Health (NIPH) in Prague are a complex of 25 national reference laboratories (NRL) and one non-reference laboratory. In December 2011, the CEM laboratories were successfully reaccredited and newly accredited as **public health laboratories** under No. 1206.4 (22 NRLs, 104 test methods) and as **test laboratories** under No. 8002 (26 laboratories, 121 test methods).

The CEM Laboratories were first accredited to ČSN EN ISO/IEC 17025 by the Czech Accreditation Institute in 2001. Since 2005, the CEM laboratories have also been accredited to ČSN EN ISO 15189.
